Learn more about each of these historic Ossining communities

We'll start at the Jug Tavern in Sparta at 3 pm. Dr. Alan Stahl, a neighborhood resident and former president of the Jug Tavern, will lead us through the landmarked Sparta district. Over the course of the six-block tour, participants will learn about the Jug Tavern and the historic homes in the neighborhood.

Then we'll move to Campwoods Grounds around 5 pm where Katie Gorycki, a resident of Campwoods for over 20 years, will guide us with a walking tour through the history of the community. What used to be a Methodist camp ground is now home to 43 families who have converted these summer cottages into full-time homes — come peek inside some of them.

The tours will conclude with a joint potluck at Campwoods Grounds. Campwoods will provide plates and utensils and will keep your food cold (or warm it up later) if you'd like to drop it off in advance of the tours.
